- In those days Caesar Augustus issued a decree that a census should be taken of the entire Roman world.

- 15 When the angels had left them and gone into heaven, the shepherds said to one another,
 - "Let's go to Bethlehem and see this thing that has happened, which the Lord has told us about."
- 16 So they hurried off and found Mary and Joseph, and the baby, who was lying in the manger.
